Teso: June 12-15

We will visit FRB's Teso program, implemented by World Renew with local partner Katakwi Integrated Program Development. Our first stop is Kampala where we will meet with World Renew staff and then travel to Soroti to visit the program area.

The Uganda-Teso program helps displaced families resettle and reestablish livelihoods after years of conflict, in areas prone to drought and flooding.



Kabale: June 16-21

After a day of rest in Kampala, we will travel to Kabale to visit the program area. FRB's Kabale program is also implemented by World Renew, with local partner PAG South Western Uganda.

FRB's Uganda-Kabale program addresses soil degradation through conservation agriculture and other soil fertility restoration practices.

Bwindi Forest: June 22-23

If there is interest, we will travel to the Bwindi Forest for a gorilla tracking expedition. There will be additional charges for this trip segment, including overnight accommodations in Bwindi and tracking permits.

Approximate Cost: \$1,700, including, ground travel, food, lodging and visas. Airfare, vaccinations and personal purchases not included.
