## Vietnam & Cambodia Learning Trip

June 3-18, 2017

### Vietnam: June 3-8

We will visit FRB's Vietnam – Tan Son program, which is implemented by Mennonite Central Committee (MCC) in cooperation with the People's Committee of Tan Son District. We will meet with MCC staff in Hanoi and will travel to Tan Son to visit the program area.

The Vietnam - Tan Son program includes training on the System of Rice Intensification (SRI), use of organic fertilizer, improved irrigation and animal husbandry skills.

### Cambodia: June 9-18

From June 9-13 we will visit FRB's Cambodia - South program, which is implemented by World Renew and several local partner organizations. After meeting with World Renew program staff in Phnom Penh, we will visit several nearby provinces where the program is working.

The Cambodia - South program focuses on intensification practices and farming systems that enhance the productivity of farms and farmers' access to markets.

From June 14-18 we will visit FRB's Cambodia - East program, which is implemented by World Hope International. We will meet program staff in Phnom Penh and then proceed to the program area to visit with farmers.

The Cambodia – East program utilizes climate-smart technologies, greenhouses and mushroom grow houses, to increase women's income.

**Approximate Cost:** \$4,000 including flights, ground travel, food, lodging and visas. Vaccinations and personal purchases not included.
